

If you have installed Windows 7, you have the XP-More program preinstalled. Just launch the program, select the virtual machine and click on the color slider in the Options bar. Why do I see the hard disk image in some folders? This happens when you run the Virtual Machine Manager program to create a virtual machine. When you launch a virtual machine, you can choose to open a Virtual Hard Disk (VHD) file as if you opened a real hard disk, but you won't

see the contents of the VHD file. This happens because the program works with a different format than Windows Explorer. What if I want to change the default color of the virtual machine? This will take around 15 minutes to complete. Create New VM. This will start the wizard where you can decide how to create your new virtual machine. You will be asked to choose between different Windows XP modes. Once the wizard is finished, your VM is ready to use. Configure VM. You will be asked to provide information about your new

virtual machine, like hostname, password and other settings. Then it is done. You will be asked if you want to start the VM. If not, you can close the wizard. Launch the VM. Now, that the VM is ready, you can launch it, just double-click on the virtual machine you created. You can test it if you're ok with some stability issues. What it does not do: It does not manage the Windows 7 environment. More information: Windows XP comes with the built-in Virtual Machine for backward compatibility. If you'd like to create a full Windows 7 environment, this will be installed on your machine when you launch the wizard. As part of the

installation, you will also need to provide an Internet connection. If you would like to create a backup of your Windows 7 installation, you'll have to do some manual work. If you're OK with some instability, you can install a software distribution that provides an older version of the Windows 7 ISO.
